**Keywords:** This section should contain maximum of 5 words that are written with 10 font size and separated with semi-colon.

### **1. INTRODUCTION (Title Times New Roman, 12 font size, bold)**

Extended abstract should be written according to the abstract structure and in a shorter form than the full article. It should be composed from the sections of **abstract and keywords**, **introduction (which will consist of introduction, literature review and objective(s)), method, findings and discussion, conclusion and implications**. It should be written with Times New Roman font, and 11 font size. It can contain figures, tables, formulations or images. Page margins are 2.5 cm wide from right, left, top and bottom. The end of the line should be aligned to the right and there should be no syllable segmentation. It should not exceed 6 pages including references and pages should not be numbered.

Current literature regarding the work subject should be examined and the differences of the said work from the past, similar works should be presented clearly in the introduction section.

# 2. METHODOLOGY

All methods that have been used in the work must be stated clearly and subtitles should be used when necessary.

#### 2.1. Subtitle

First degree titles (2.) should be written left aligned, all caps and bold. Second and 3rd degree subtitles (2.1, 2.1.1) should be written left aligned, bold and with title case. A blank line should be placed between the paragraphs and there should not be any paragraph indentation.




Figure 1: Points Scored
