

MASTER OF LANGUAGE IN COMMUNICATION AND DIGITAL CULTURE

A new taught course programme at Language Academy, UTM ...will be offered soon!

The Master of Language in Communication and Digital Culture is a new postgraduate programme in the area of language and communication. It is the only Master's programme in Malaysia and among the few in the Asian region which incorporates language and communication with an emphasis on the emerging modes of communication. The curriculum is not limited to the study of English and Malay but extends to other global languages such as Arabic, Japanese, Mandarin and French.

This 45 credit hour graduate programme can be taken either full time or part time. Full time students will have a minimum of three semesters (1 ½ years) and a maximum of six semesters (3 years) to complete the programme. Those who undertake part time study will have a minimum of four semesters (2 years) and a maximum of eight semesters (4 years) to complete.

In order to graduate, students will be required to undertake the following courses:

Elective Courses: 4 x 3 credits (e.g. Language, Media and Globalisation, Persuasive Communication, Popular Culture and the Internet, Language Training Design, Literacy in the Digital Age & Bahasia Media uringsi dan Budaya Digital)	12
University General Course: 1 x 3 credits	3
Master's Project: 4 + 5 credits (Project I and Project II)	9
Total credit hours to graduate	45





