	<p>i. University General Course</p> <p>Students can select one from 11 University General Course as listed above. All these courses have at least one similar Programme Learning Outcome attainment which is Communication Skills. If there are no courses offered in the programme, however students are allowed to join other courses conducted by any faculty.</p> <p>ii. Research Methodology (UHPP 6013)</p> <p>In this course, students are taught how to conduct research. Starting from how to formulate a problem statement, outlining the objectives and defining the scope, conducting a literature review, experiment, survey and analysis, and finally making conclusions. A few tricks and tips on writing a thesis and viva are also explained.</p> <p>Apart from these two courses, all doctoral/master full research programmes require students to complete a doctoral thesis.</p>
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
